

Town Council Actions April 10, 2018

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- 1) Received an update from Gina Hilliard on the Luray-Page Chamber of Commerce indicating membership has increased and informing Council of Monthly Highlights and Upcoming Events the Chamber will be participating in.
- 2) Adopted the proposed FY 2018-2019 Budget in the amount of \$2,414,510.
- 3) Heard there will be an Introduction to Microsoft Word class held every Tuesday and Thursday evening from 6:00 pm to 7:00 pm, starting on April 24, 2018 and lasting until May 24, 2018. The cost of the 10-hour class is \$10.00. This cost includes the materials each student will receive, which consists of a notebook and instructional material. In order to attend this course, you must pre-register by calling the Shenandoah Computer Center at 540-652-8773. Registration is complete once you have submitted your \$10.00 fee. Class size is limited to 10 persons, so sign up early if you plan to attend.
