- 1) Approved a request for a zoning permit from the Town of Shenandoah for the consolidation of two (2) smaller lots into one (1) larger lot at 406 First Street.
- 2) Approved a request for a zoning permit from the Shenandoah Assembly of God Church for the consolidation of four (4) smaller lots into two (2) larger lots at 607 Eighth Street.
- 3) Approved a request for a zoning permit from Mark and Bronson Caudill for the subdivision of one (1) larger lot into two (2) smaller lots at their property on Second Street.
