

Town Council Actions May 14, 2019

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- 1) Adopted an employee-paid long-term care insurance agreement with the Virginia Retirement System through Genworth Life Insurance Co. This long-term care is at no cost to the Town and employees will have the option of participating in this program.
- 2) Declined an offer from Green Ridge Recycling and Disposal Facility, LLC. to reserve disposal capacity at a proposed landfill in Cumberland County, Virginia.
- 3) Adopted a proclamation for Kids to Park Day, which designates May 18, 2019 as a day to encourage families to get outdoors and visit a neighborhood, state, or national park.
- 4) Received a copy of the Town's 2018 Annual Drinking Water Quality Report and January 2019 Notice for review. **Note:** Copies of this report are available to residents at the Town Hall. It is also available online at <http://www.townofshenandoah.com/water-quality-report.html>
- 5) Reviewed the April 2019 Town Vehicle Gas Logs.
- 6) Received the April 2019 Police Department Activity Log for review.
- 7) Received an invitation from Lord Fairfax Community College to the groundbreaking ceremony for the Russell A. and Rodney A. Jenkins Hall being held on May 16, 2019 at 3:00 pm.
- 8) Authorized the Town to put sod in front of a home on Eighth Street where the yard had to be dug up for the installation of a water and sewer connection for a new home construction. It was noted the Town usually puts down grass seed, but the Council is willing to make a one-time exception for this house as the previously placed grass seed continues washing out.
- 9) Authorized a plaque to be given to the Sullivan family for the Shenandoah Grocery operating for 40 years. This business will close in May 2019.
- 10) Authorized two plaques to be given to the family of Dave Hinkle to honor him for his service to the Town as a Council Member, as well as a volunteer for the community. The Council especially noted their appreciation for Dave's dedication to the Town's Annual Memorial Festival for over 20 years.
- 11) Authorized hiring Mark Armentrout as a part-time equipment operator, effective May 15, 2019, as needed only.
- 12) Authorized the renewal of the parking lot lease with the Post Office for \$157.50 per month, effective June 1, 2019 to May 31, 2024.
