- 1) Authorized the purchase of 3 bullet proof vests for the police officers at a total cost of \$2,379.00. It was noted the Bullet Proof Vests Grant will reimburse the Town 50% of the approved costs.
- 2) Received a copy of a Public Service Notice to inform residents that the water pressure may be reduced in Town from Friday, May 31, 2019, until Friday, June 14, 2019, to allow for Utility Tank Service to clean, and wash out both Tenth Street and Twelfth Street Water Tanks. It was noted this is a necessary maintenance procedure and understanding during this time will be greatly appreciated.
- 3) Received a thank you letter from CHOICES, the Council on Domestic Violence for Page County, Inc., for the Town's donation of \$500.00.
- 4) Approved amending budgeted line items within the current FY 18-19 budget, as presented.
- 5) Donald Muelenburg presented Council with a request for the Town to lease and utilize his property on Williams Avenue as a public picnic area. The Council noted their appreciation for the offer and agreed to further explore the option.
- 6) The Council expressed their appreciation for the Page Youth Football League's donation of a Memorial Flag for Dave Hinkle, to be kept in the Town Museum.
