

## Town Council Actions June 11, 2019

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- 1) Presented two Community Enhancement Awards for Boxcar Deli & Subs and Four Seasons Gifts & Décor for the expansion and renovations made to the businesses, owned by Dan & Brenda Haggett.
- 2) Authorized closing the Town Office July 9<sup>th</sup> thru July 11<sup>th</sup>, 2019 to close out the books for fiscal year 2018-2019 and to set up the new fiscal year 2019-2020, in preparation for the Town's audit.
- 3) Reappointed Francis "Frank" Worley and Nancy Karnes to four-year terms on the Industrial Development Authority, expiring 11/13/2022. Appointed I. Michael Lowe to a fill a vacant position on the Industrial Development Authority, with a term expiring 11/13/2021.
- 4) Approved water and sewer connection for Morgan Andrews and Tyler Jenkins on lot 49 in the Forest Knolls Subdivision.
- 5) Authorized the purchase of a train play structure and ADA compliant surface, at a cost of \$27,720, as a part of Phase II of the WigWam Village playground replacement. It was noted this purchase is subject to the Town's receipt of the remainder of the HCAT grant and a planned citizen donation.
- 6) Appointed Lynn Fox to fill the vacant position of Secretary/Treasurer for the Shenandoah Wireless Broadband Authority.
- 7) Members of the Luray-Page County Chamber of Commerce's Executive Committee, John Shaffer and Leah Pence, commended Mayor Lucas and Council Members on their continued work in Shenandoah.
