- 1) Approved signing a one (1) year lease between the Town and the Shenandoah Recreation League for use of the Batting Cage and Office area located at 565 Long Avenue, as presented.

- 3) Adopted a Resolution for the 2018 Regional Hazard Mitigation Plan.
