

Town Council Actions September 24, 2019

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- 1) A Joint Public Hearing was held, prior to the regular Town Council Meeting, to discuss the Town of Shenandoah's rezoning request from Residential (R2) to Industrial on the entire parcels of property located at 102 Back Road, identified by Tax Map numbers: 102A5-(1)-4, 5, 6, and 102A5-(1)-13, 14, 15, and 16. Following this Public Hearing, with the Planning Commission's recommendation, the Council approved the rezoning request from the Town of Shenandoah, as presented.
- 2) Received the Town website statistics for August 2019.
- 3) Reviewed the August 2019 Police Department Activity logs.
- 4) Appointed Teresa Kite to fill the vacancy on the Town Planning Commission, with a term expiring 10/01/2020.
- 5) Appointed Karen Comer to fill the vacancy on the Town Planning Commission, with a term expiring 10/01/2021.
- 6) Approved a request for a zoning permit from Brenda Mercer (Trustee of the William L. Lam Trust) for the consolidation of three (3) smaller lots into two (2) larger lots, at 702 Fifth Street and adjacent lots, identified by Tax Map numbers: 102A3-(1)-1-14, 15, and 16.
- 7) Authorized payment of \$13,000.00 to Constable Construction Inc. for an emergency sewer line replacement on Bank Street. It was noted this price excludes rock removal, stone costs, and material costs.
- 8) Pastor Todd Stroupe invited members of Council and the community to attend the Shenandoah Valley Church of God, where service starts at 10:30 am every Sunday in the cafeteria of the Shenandoah Elementary School. The Church offers Sunday School classes for all ages, including a nursery for infants.
