- 1) Heard the Town's 8th Annual Veterans Service will be held November 10, 2019 at 3:00 pm at the Veterans Park on Virginia Avenue. Everyone is invited to attend this service and thank a Veteran. Mayor Lucas noted the service is planned to be held outside, but an indoor location may be announced closer to the date if colder weather, rain, or snow is forecasted.

- 3) Authorized the purchase of equipment for Outdoor Movie Nights, at a cost up to \$3,000.00.

- 5) Authorized Steve Breeden changing his title to Mechanic, in addition to still having General Maintenance Worker duties, at a yearly salary of \$25,000.00.
- 6) Authorized hiring Josh Lam as a full time General Maintenance Worker with a starting salary of \$25,000.00, with \$1,000.00 raise after obtaining his CDL License, and a 5% raise after passing his probation.
