

## Town Council Actions January 28, 2020

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- 1) Received an invitation to Local Government Day being held February 6, 2020, beginning at 11:00 am, at the Omni Richmond Hotel. Local Government representatives can register for this program at [www.vml.org](http://www.vml.org).
- 2) Approved a 48-month lease with Ricoh for a new copier at Town Hall, at a cost of \$159.91 per month., to replace the copier lease which expired December 2019.
- 3) Heard a reminder the 5<sup>th</sup> Annual First Responders Dinner will be held at the Christ United Methodist Church Fellowship Hall on February 8, 2020 beginning at 6 pm.
- 4) Rescinded authorization for Don Largent Roofing, Inc. to replace the roof on the Sewer Plant Pump House at a cost of \$5,196.00. Funds transfer from Utility Capital Improvement Account to Utility Checking account.
- 5) Approved purchase of Traffic Safety signs at cost of \$2,642.00. Funds transfer from General Capital Improvement Account to General Checking account.
- 6) Approved water and sewer connection for new house on Fifth Street to be built by Superior Siding.
