

Town Council Actions February 11, 2020

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- 1) Approved payment by the Town of Shenandoah to the Page County Economic Development in the amount of 75% of the December 2019 machine and tools tax paid by Tactical Walls, LLC. to the terms of the Performance Agreement between the Page County Economic Development Authority and Tactical Walls, LLC. and RHB Real Estate, LLC. in order to facilitate economic growth in the Town of Shenandoah. Once payment is received by the EDA, the EDA shall remit payment to Tactical Walls, LLC. and/or RHB Real Estate, LLC.
- 2) Adopted an ordinance to renew the nonexclusive franchise for Rural Broadband Network Services, LLC.
- 3) Granted a powerline easement to Shenandoah Valley Electric Cooperative on Town-owned lots identified by tax map numbers 102A5-1-60-6,13,14, and 15.
- 4) Authorized the purchase of 30 Christmas pole decorations and hardware, at a cost of \$8,700.00 plus shipping, to be paid from the General Reserved for Contingency budgeted line item.
- 5) Tabled a request from Shenandoah Volunteer Fire Company to consider vacating an undeveloped portion of a street. It was noted further negotiations would need to be made for the property in question and a Public Hearing would need to be held prior to the Council being able to properly vacate this street.
- 6) Received a thank you letter for the Town's donation to the Making a Difference Backpack Ministry.
- 7) Heard Lord Fairfax Community College is holding an Entrepreneurship Workshop February 21, 2020 (Snow Date February 28) from 9am to 3pm at the Luray-Page County Center. Topics to be covered include characteristics of a successful entrepreneur, the importance of a business plan, the mission and vision of the organization, and effective cash management.
