- 1) Adopted an ordinance defining the basis for tax assessment and establishing the Real Estate and Mobile Home tax rates at \$0.34 per hundred for 2020. (**Note:** There were no changes from the 2019 tax rates,)
- 2) Adopted an ordinance defining the basis for tax assessment and establishing the Machinery and Tools and Personal Property tax rates for 2020. (**Note:** There were no changes from the 2019 tax rates.)
- 3) Reviewed the March 2020 Town Vehicle Gas logs.
- 4) Heard Steve Breeden has passed his six-month probationary period as a Mechanic and authorized him for a 5% pay increase effective with the next payroll.
- 5) Heard Joshua Lam has passed his six-month probationary period as a General Maintenance Worker and authorized him for a 5% pay increase effective with the next payroll. It was noted the CDL requirement for this position has been extended until the COVID-19 pandemic is over.
- 6) Heard Town Manager Roudabush is obtaining bids for street repairs and hopes to have them for Council to review at the next regular Council Meeting.
- 7) Heard the Budget Public Hearing will be held electronically on April 28, 2020 at 7:00 pm. The Regular Council Meeting will follow this Public Hearing.
