- 1) Adopted the proposed FY 2020-2021 Budget in the amount of \$2,754,204.
- 2) Received a copy of the Town's Annual Drinking Water Quality Report for calendar year 2019. The report stated no drinking water violations occurred in calendar year 2019.
- 3) Received a copy of the Town's Annual Audit Report for FY ending June 30, 2019.
- 4) Reviewed the April 2020 Town Vehicle Gas Log.
- 5) Website Administrator, Joyce Fluharty, provided a copy of the Town Website Statistics for the Council to review.
- 6) Reviewed the April 2020 Police Department Activity Log.
- 7) Heard the Virginia Department of Transportation is making repairs to the sidewalk and curb on Maryland Avenue near the elementary school. VDOT also plans to pave Highway 340 from Virginia Avenue to Grove Hill River Bridge and a couple of Town streets within the coming weeks.
- 8) The following items were reported during the Industrial, Economic Development & Procurement committee portion of the meeting:
 - Rudy's Diner and Mamma Mia Italian Restaurant have recently renovated the interior of their restaurants.
