

- 1) Adopted a **draft** policy document for Infectious Disease Prevention Emergency Temporary Standards for the Town, as required by Virginia Occupational Safety & Health.
- 2) Approved payment \$12,288.32 less \$257.77 discount (\$12,630.55) to Burner Well Drilling Inc, for parts and labor for well pump motor replacement. The Town's insurance reimbursed \$11,630.55 after \$1,000 deductible.
- 3) Amended budget line items in Parks and Recreation for the salary of the part time Parks and Rec employee. \$5,374 will be moved from park maintenance to salaries.
- 4) Heard there is a possible water leak on Route 340 near the entrance to the cemetery.
- 5) Was advised in the event of a leak at the fitting on a water meter would be the only time an adjustment could be made to a customer's water bill when the water has gone through the meter. All other leaks between the meter and the house are the responsibility of the property owner.
- 6) Heard VDOT needs to be contacted for an area just outside of the Town limits on Shenandoah River Road where the road is sinking.
- 7) Asked Public Works to fill in around the water meter at Junior and Hockman Avenue.
- 8) Authorized the purchase of grills to be placed at the River Park.
- 9) Heard the wheels on the cannon at Shenandoah Elementary School are in need of repair.
- 10) Heard Morrison Road and other areas at the River Park have potholes that need to be filled in.
- 11) Heard the Town is looking for a Town business that is also a member of the Chamber of Commerce to co-host Business After Hours on August 20, 2020.
- 12) Authorized a Community Enhancement Award to be presented at a future meeting.
- 13) Heard Kirk Comer has accepted the part-time Parks and Recreation position and will begin work on Saturday, August 1, 2020.
