- 1) September 2020 Community Enhancement Award recipients are Mark and Stephanie Wentz, 102 Corcoran Avenue.
- 2) Received a copy of the official award letter from DCJS, which provides \$43,068 in federal grant funds. This will pay the new police officer's salary for the first year of employment. The award does not include benefits or insurance.
- 3) Approved a request from the Shenandoah Volunteer Fire Company to submit expenses in the amount of \$9,185.73 to Page County for reimbursement through the CARES Act. If approved, the funds would be paid from the amount allocated by Page County for the Town of Shenandoah.
- 4) Received an update from Page County Department of Social Services hours of operation and services currently available.
- 5) Received invitations to Virtual Evening With The Stars, to be held Thursday, September 24, 2020 from 4:00 to 6:00 pm. The event is sponsored by LFCC.
- 6) Received the Luray-Page County Chamber of Commerce September 2020 newsletter.
- 7) Received the August 2020 Vehicle Gas logs for review.
- 8) Heard there are several water leaks in Town on the schedule to be repaired as soon as possible. Also, the Town Manager will investigate other areas of concern to determine if there are water leaks present.

- 10) Thanked Kirk Comer, recently hired as part-time parks and rec worker, for his work on the weekends in the Town's parks.
