BSA Troop 8 requests permission to use to Town of Shenandoah logo for creation of a patch to be sewn to troop neckerchiefs.

Background: The Scout neckerchief is a key component of the Scout uniform, which is worn by more than 50 million scouts in more than 200 countries around the world.

Scout Troops can choose the color and design of unit neckerchiefs.

Scouts were first established in the Town of Shenandoah in 1913 and have contributed to civic projects and events since then. Troop 8 requests use of the logo to reflect our historical connection to the Town of Shenandoah and the Native American history of the area.

Troop 8 affirms that:

- We are a non-profit organization, chartered by the Lions Club of Shenandoah.
- We will neither sell, monetize, nor disparage the logo in any way.
- The use of the logo is limited only to use on Troop neckerchiefs.
- The Troop will not reproduce for any other purpose unless additional permissions are granted.
- The Troop may provide a sample of the logo in its intended form if requested.

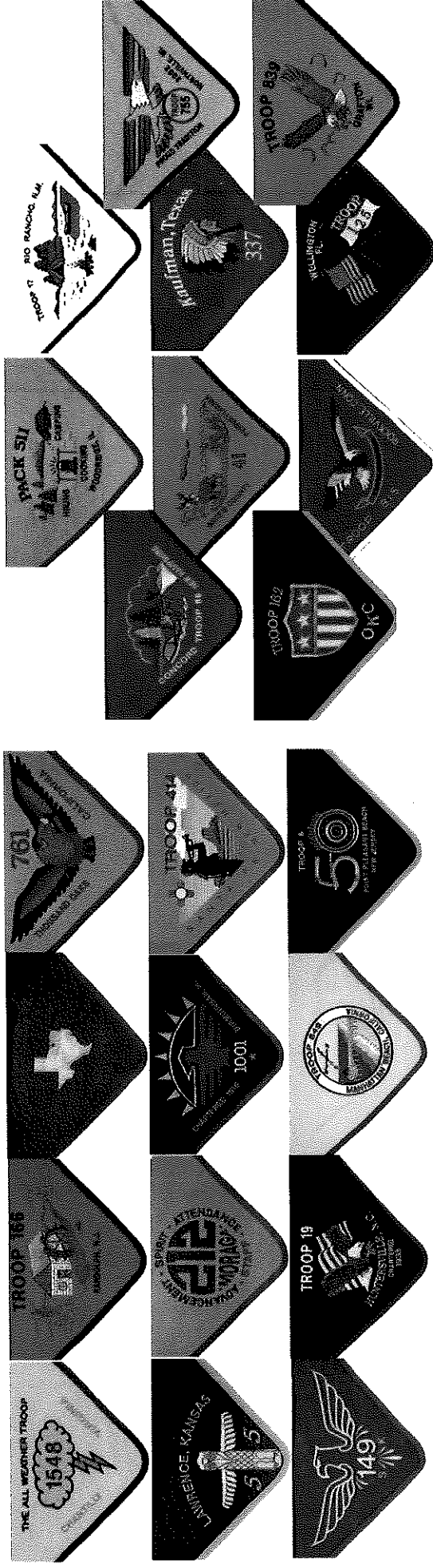
